

LeSauk Township Annual Road Inspection

April 20, 2017

The annual road inspection meeting of the LeSauk Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Dan Heim at 4:00 p.m. at which time the Town Board members traveled all roads.

PRESENT: Supervisors Jeff Westerlund, Shawn Omann and Dan Heim and Clerk Marlyce Plante

Areas and possible work to be done on the township roads are as follows:

Sweeping –

- All platted additions of the township will be swept by ASTECH and they will record how many pounds of sand were swept in order to meet the regulations of the NPDES Permit.

Striping –

- Rosewood Road, possible striping
- 30th Street – does not look bad, but could be included in proposal.
- 35th Street
- 30th Avenue No. –
- 40th Street – possible striping after patching or overlay is completed.

Crack fill –

- 22nd St. No – Crack fill

Pothole Repair -

- 22nd St. – Small pot hole repair near #288
- 30th St. No – potholes midway into the township portion.
- 35th St. – Several small pot holes.
- 1st St. North – A couple of small pot holes
- 30th Avenue – Many small pot holes.
- County Road 4 & 1st Street North – Couple of small pot holes (May be county area)
- 321st Street North – Pot holes by 3152, 3226 and 3300 homes.

Road Repair or Minimum Overlay

- Pinecone Road & 40th St. No. – Both roads need an overlay. The Town Board may piggyback with the City of Sartell when Pinecone Road is redone in 2018 due to the construction of the new high school
- 322nd St. – St. Cloud handles the patching, some is needed by the Kundrat home.
- County Road 1 & 27th Street North – breakaway of asphalt on the southeast corner.
- Breakaway of Winnebago Road near the Coborn parcel.

Brush & Tree Trimming -

- Winnebago Road – Overhanging bushes have been trimmed by Supv Westerlund, looks good, but may need further trimming once foliage comes out.
- Spider Court – Overhanging trees need trimming.

Miscellaneous items –

- Street Sign at Pinecone. 55th Avenue & 40th Street – Clerk Plante will order a new one through M-R Sign Company.

- 911 Signs, some are still located on the west side of 5th Avenue. Contact property owners to have them moved to the east side near their mail box. Are we going to do this? Maybe Sign Solutions can handle this if we contract with them for replacement of township street signs
- 17th St. North – by the Udermann farm – very rough – have fill put down and grade as soon as possible.
- 17th St. North & 30th Avenue North – Is there a culvert under this road which is probably plugged since water is backing up on the north side and a small water flow is running over 17th St.
- 17th St. North – Minimum maintenance road off Pinecone Road. Culvert in very poor shape and the top of the culvert is exposed a little. Discussion on whether a load of class 5 could be brought in and placed over the culvert along with grading of the road.
- 5th Avenue North – Black dirt needs to be finished from road replacement in 2015.
- 5-Ton sign needs to be replaced on township portion of Pinecone Road.
- Joyce Zimmerman Parcel – Too wet to enter, Supv Westerlund will view during his May road inspection.
- 30th Ave Bridge – Bolts need to be tightened yet as requested by Stearns County Highway Dept.
- Divine Grace Mobile Home Park – many cars and junk laying around.
- Then property clean up – Some progress has been made, board members will view during their monthly road inspections to see if continued progress is made.
- River Vista Lane – Chevron board is broken and needs replacing.
- Snail Drive – Chevron board is broken and needs replacing.
- River Oaks Lane – Street light near the Ferber parcel is still unlit. Contact Xcel Energy.
