Areas and possible work to be done on the Township roads are as follows:

Sweeping -

- All the platted additions of the Township have been swept by ASTECH, and they will record how many pounds of sand were swept in order to meet the regulations of the NPDES Permit.

Striping -

- 35th Street - possible striping

Crack fill -

- Monarch Court

Pothole Repair -

- 27th Street North - patch by County Road 1 ROW
- Winnebago - by #2578 and across the road from #2578
- 30th Street North - patch by County Road 1 ROW
- Riviera Road - by #3329
- 22nd Street North - by #288 & by County Road 1 ROW
- 321st Street (Foley Street) - by #3124 & #3257
- 322nd Street (Pleasantdale Addn) - small pothole in cul-de-sac
- 322nd Street - some small potholes
- 1st Street North - small pothole east of stop sign by 30th Ave
- Pine Cone Road North - lots of small potholes and cracks. May be resurfaced this year
- 40th Street North - lots of small potholes & cracks
- 30th Ave North - lots of small potholes and cracks


Miscellaneous Items -

- 17th Street North off Pine Cone Road - needs grading
- 17th Street North off of 30th Ave - needs Grading
- Majestic Pond Court - straighten signs, both signs read Majestic Pond Drive
- Spruce Court - sign needs to be replaced

- Bonhomie Valley Addition - barricades need new boards
- Monarch Court - can we put light on post on south side of 21st Street
- River Oaks Lane - barricades need new boards
- River Vista Lane - barricades need new boards
- River Vista Lane - call CenturyLink about raised manhole cover in ROW
