

LeSauk Township Annual Road Inspection Meeting
May 7, 2019

The Annual Road Inspection Meeting was called to order by Chairman Dan Heim at 4:00 p.m. in the Town Hall.

PRESENT: Supervisors Dan Heim, Jeff Westerlund and Shawn Omann and Clerk Marlyce Plante.

The Town Board traveled all township roads. The majority of the roads within the township are in good driving condition. The following were found areas that needed to be addressed:

Pothole areas to be filled as soon as possible

- Riviera Road near house number 3054.
- 40th Street North – this road is being overlayed this summer, but some potholes may need to be filled prior to the overlay due to the Apple Duathlon race being held on Memorial Day weekend.
- 35th Street North – Road is in very poor condition and will most likely be the next road to overlay. When viewing the roads with Doug Welk of ASTECH Inc., discuss with him what could be done until the overlay work can be done.
- 30th Ave. North – Pothole located south of the bridge.
- 322nd St. North – Quite a few smaller potholes which St. Cloud will be asked to fill.
- 321st St. No. – Potholes located in several areas. One larger one had been filled.

Road Signs

- 27th Street No & 5th Avenue sign needs to be straightened.
- 2 “End of Road” signs at the end of River Oaks Lane were damaged and need to be replaced. Signs & posts were picked up by Supv Omann.

Miscellaneous

- 17th St. North (Udermann’s) needs to be graded as soon as possible since it is in very poor condition. Supv Westerlund will contact ASTECH Inc.
- Rosewood Road & County Road 1 Intersection shoulder is broken up – this is located in the county road right of way.
- 22nd St. North & Rodeo Road – When viewing the roads with Doug Welk, discuss possibilities to lengthen the life of the both roads.

A township supervisor will set a time to drive the roads with Doug Welk of ASTECH Inc. to discuss and have Mr. Welk give suggestions & direction to which roads should be fixed first and what can be done to lengthen the life of the township roads.
