Pine Ridge Road – Small potholes at 394 & 341 Pine Ridge Rd – Approximately 3 bags of cold patch – This road could be considered for blow patching since many of the potholes are shallow.

Stork Drive – Drainage area is working well with the number of recent rains. Supv Omann viewed the area earlier and the water was even with the road way, but now has all drained.

 30^{th} St. No – Buckthorn bushes & small trees need to be removed. Have estimates to either eradicate or cut and have stumps ground out, as soon as possible.

3157 & 3275 Riviera Road – Small potholes – Approximately 3-4 bags of cold patch. This road could be considered for blow patching since many of the potholes are shallow.

326 22nd St. – Small potholes – Approximately 2 bags of cold patch.

321st/Foley Street - Small potholes - Approximately 1 bag of cold patch.

- 35th Street Overlayed 2 years ago 1st round of crack seal due.
- Pinecone Road

LeSauk Township Annual Road Inspection Meeting May 12, 2022

The Annual Road Inspection Meeting was called to order by Chairman Dan Heim at 4:00 p.m.

PRESENT: Supervisors Dan Heim, Jeff Westerlund and Shawn Omann and Clerk Marlyce Plante.

The Town Board traveled all township roads. Due to the area receiving a record amount of rain, many areas of the township had standing water. Culverts and areas prone to flooding, were especially looked at to ensure good water flow.

61st Ave. – Pleasant Dale Addition - Water was found to be standing on 61st Avenue neat the 321st & 61st intersection. This area has a low spot in the roadway, and after a heavier rain, water pools in the low area, but subsides within a day or two.

32074 61st Ave. – Potholes that need cold patch – Approximately 3 bags of cold patch.

32158 62nd Ave. – All trees have been cut down between the Winter & Barringer properties.

6124 321st St. – Borud property – The lilac bushes have been trimmed down substantially which allows easier traffic & pedestrian viewing when maneuvering the corner of 321st & 62nd Ave.

322nd Street – The Board discussed having the City of St. Cloud take over this street since the south side will be in the city of St. Cloud when the Buecker's property is annexed. Some potholes have been filled, possibly by the City of St. Cloud, but several still remain.

6173 322nd St. – Several small potholes - Approximately 3 bags of cold patch.

1st St. No. – Small potholes near 2583 1st St. – Approximately 2 bags of cold patch.

 30^{th} Avenue – This street is in the poorest condition. The Town Board, along with all other jurisdictions of 30^{th} , are working with legislature who have applied for grant funding to reconstruct and upgrade the road.

17th St. No. – Udermann area - This area was recently been graded. Supv Westerlund questioned whether this street could be overlayed. It was the consensus that with the heavy farm equipment travel on this road and the high expense to overlay the street, township funds would be better used on other road projects. T

322nd St. – This street is in poor condition but has been patched by St. Cloud since the majority of the south side is in the city. There is a lot of traffic on this road, both trucks, cars and farm equipment. Patch and fix as needed.

 40^{th} St. – Large pothole near 1986 40^{th} St. No. – Approximately 4 bags of cold patch. East side of 40^{th} in generally good condition. West side of 40^{th} is in Brockway Township.

7th Ave. No. – Small potholes near 2606 7th Ave – Approximately 2-3 bags of cold patch. This road could be considered for blow patching since many of the potholes are shallow.
